Training

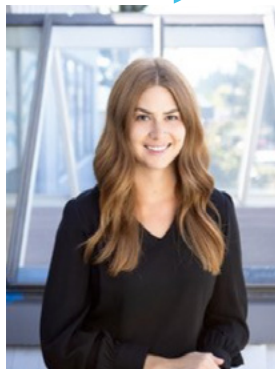
Practice
